
SUBJECT: ROUTINE BILATERAL SCREENING

1. TOMO CC views to include as much of the lateral tissue and TOMO MLO views are to be obtained. A 90-degree TOMO lateral can be substituted for the TOMO MLO view.
2. **TOMO** Exaggerated CC or TOMO Axillary Tail views will only be done if patient has accessory lateral tissue or if all of the patient's breast can't be seen on standard TOMO views.
3. The nipple should be tangential in at least 1 view. **Tangential views are not required.**
4. If patient has chronic pain and referring doctor has ordered screening exam, note this in the Study notes for the Radiologist.
5. If patient is from "out of town", show images to Radiologist.

ULTRASOUND FOLLOW-UP REQUESTED
WITH SCREENING MAMMO

If a Breast Ultrasound is requested after a Screening Mammogram, we are to show the "Radiologist of the day" and give him/her the Breast History Sheet, as a reminder that the Screening Mammogram needs to be read with the follow-US.
