

Dr. BINETTE HYSTEROSALPINGOGRAM

Remind Dr.'s Office of appt. when pt. arrives!!

ASK IF PATIENT FAMILY CAN BE IN ROOM!

- SUPPLIES:**
1. Akrad HSG Catheter
 2. Metal Speculum
 3. 12 cc Syringe
 4. 18g x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ needle
 5. Large straight Hemostats
 6. Tenaculum
 7. sterile bowl w/ betadine
 8. sterile drape
 9. goose neck lamp
 10. Omnipaque 300
 11. . 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ gloves
 12. stirrups
 13. sanitary pad

PROCEDURE: place linen sheet on table with chucks, stirrups at end of table w/ pillow cases covering. Place sterile drape on tray, add other sterile supplies and betadine in bowl. Dr. will draw up contrast when he arrives.

Get Patients History of Allergies, Pregnancies, Miscarriages, Surgeries and Day of cycle (can not be spotting) **write on consent form (G)** pregnancies, (P) deliveries, (AB) miscarriages, abortions.

Explain procedure to patient and have release signed (copy after Dr. signs and give to him). Place Patient supine and take SCOUT (pelvic outlet). Place pt. in stirrups when Dr Arrives. After cath. placed pull pt. up table, TECH operates Fluoro for Dr. Give pt. panty liner when procedure over, explain that there will be discharge from contrast (clear but sticky, betadine brown, and spotting from catheter). Anything more than spotting they call Dr Binette about.
