

DR YOUNG

ACBE

SCOUT: AP abdomen (2 crosswise if large pt)

SUPPLIES: Large empty double contrast enema bag w/ tip
Balloon inflator and bulb for air contrast (check balloon)
Heated Polibar (place jug in bucket HOT water in sink)
Compression Paddle

PROCEDURE: Warm Ba prior to patients arrival
Show Dr. Scout
Insert enema tip in patient, then get Dr for exam
Assist Dr. with Barium, start supine to fill
Table upright, drain Barium into bag, close valve
Dr. will put in air then take upright images of flexures
Table Supine again, take overheads when Dr. leaves room

OVERHEADS: AP, LPO, ANGLED LPO
BOTH DECUBES
CROSS TABLE LATERAL WITH TIP OUT
